PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

2. Respondent was sent a Notice of Failure to File on December 28, 2007 and subsequently, on March 11, 2008, he was sent a Notice of Delinquency.
3. Respondent was sent a Notice of Hearing on July 2, 2008.
4. The hearing was concluded on August 18, 2008 at 3:00p.m. in Albany, New York. Respondent failed to appear.
