Failure to Timely File a 2007 January/June  
Client Semi-Annual Report

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At its February 3, 2009 meeting, the New York State Commission on Public Integrity ("Commission") considered the hearing officer's findings of fact and recommendation in the above-captioned matter.

The Commission affirmed the hearing officer's finding that Respondent knowingly and wilfully failed to timely file the 2007 January/June Client Semi-Annual Report ("Report"), directed Respondent to file with the Commission the Report and remit, by certified check made payable to the New York State Commission on Public Integrity, a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500, if Respondent properly completes the Report and returns it to the Commission within fifteen (15) days of receipt of service of the Decision of the Commission ("Decision"); or a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000, if Respondent properly completes the Report and returns it to the Commission on or after sixteen (16) days but within thirty (30) days following receipt of service of the Decision; or a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000 if Respondent properly completes the Report and returns it to the Commission on or after thirty-one (31) days following receipt of service of the Decision.
