Failure to Timely File an Annual Statement of
Financial Disclosure for 2008

The New York State Commission on Public Integrity, at its June 10, 2010 meeting, having considered the hearing officer's findings of fact and recommendation in the above-captioned case, affirms the hearing officer's findings that you knowingly and wilfully failed to timely file an annual statement of financial disclosure for calendar year 2008.

- Respondent was required to file the annual statement of financial disclosure ("Statement") for calendar year 2008 by November 15, 2009, as required by Public Officers Law §73-a, because Respondent was designated as an academic threshold employee by her employer.
- Respondent was sent a Notice of Failure to File on December 2, 2009 and subsequently, on February 9, 2010, she was sent a Notice of Delinquency.
- Respondent was sent a Notice of Hearing on March 2, 2010.
- The hearing was concluded on April 12, 2010 at 11:30a.m. in Albany, New York. Respondent failed to appear.

You are directed to remit to the Commission on Public Integrity by certified check made payable to the New York State Commission on Public Integrity, a civil penalty in the amount of \$400 within 30 days of receipt of this decision.
