Dear Mr. Pope,

As you know, the Office of the Inspector General is investigating allegations that the New York State Police, at the direction of Governor's Office, inappropriately maintained or created records on Senator Joseph Bruno's travel. We ask that you produce the following documents to the Office of the Inspector General:

- For the time period January 2007 to present, any and all documents maintained by the Executive Chamber relating to executive aviation travel and ground transportation provided by the New York State Police;
- For the time period January 2007 to present, any and all communications in any form whatsoever, including but not limited to electronic communications and phone logs, between any member of the Executive Chamber and the New York State Police, concerning State Police transportation provided for Joseph Bruno;
- For the time period January 2007 to July 1, 2007, any and all communications between the Executive Chamber and the media relating to the issue of aviation travel and ground transportation, including but not limited to FOIL requests and responses.

The Inspector General will need to interview members of the Executive Chamber, including but not limited to William Howard, Darren Dopp, Marlene Turner and Terry Brennan. We will coordinate through your office to do so. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
