



JCOPE TO HOST WEBEX TRAINING FOR ONLINE LOBBYING FILING SYSTEM

In anticipation of the July 15 deadline for lobbyist and client filings, in the coming weeks, the Joint Commission on Public Ethics (JCOPE) will be offering training sessions for users of its online lobbying filing system. This training is designed to provide lobbyist and client filers with a thorough introduction to the online filing system, including registering for an online profile, logging into the system, submitting lobbyist registration statements, and filing regular lobbyist bimonthly and client semiannual reports. While all filers are welcome to attend, the training is designed for new filers or existing filers who are new to filing online.

Trainings will be conducted via WebEx on July 1 and July 9 at 10 a.m. and should last approximately one hour. Interested parties should email education@jcope.ny.gov, including all attendees' names, organizational affiliations, dates of preferred sessions, and whether the attendees intend to file as lobbyists, clients, or both.

WebEx is a video conferencing platform that allows users to attend meetings and to interact with others via a desktop or laptop computer. You will receive information with a link to the WebEx training, including login information, after you have registered for a training session.
