

# ETHICS REMINDERS

*It's not all in the family...*  
**Remember the Nepotism restrictions in the Public Officers Law**

Public Officers Law § 73(14) prohibits a State employee from participating in any decision to hire, promote, discipline, or discharge a relative who is, or under consideration to become, a State employee.

This rule effectively prohibits a State employee from directly or indirectly supervising a relative.

Before you engage in any official decision regarding a relative, or if you are unsure if you have participated in a decision concerning a relative's employment, you should contact JCOPE for guidance.



***Remember:***

Violating Public Officers Law § 73 can result in a maximum fine of \$40,000. The Joint Commission on Public Ethics periodically releases Ethics Reminders.
