You should not answer that question.


Indeed, given that the IG is now investigating this, I would strongly recommend that you not communicate with Dicker (or anyone else) as to what happened, or when.

Eventually, the IG will interview you (and others) about all this, and you should not be gathering information about this separately and passing it along to the press (or anyone else).

We have already publicly stated that there is no truth to the allegations. If Dicker or anyone else asks for specific details, your "stock answer" should simply be that the matter has been referred to the IG and that we won't have any comment on the matter until that investigation is over.
