The New York State Commission on Public Integrity, at its October 22, 2009 meeting, having considered the hearing officer's findings of fact and recommendation in the above-captioned case, affirms the hearing officer's findings that you knowingly and wilfully failed to file an annual statement of financial disclosure for calendar year 2007.

You are directed to remit to the Commission on Public Integrity your 2007 Annual Statement of Financial Disclosure and, by certified check made payable to the New York State Commission on Public Integrity, a civil penalty in the amount of \$600 if the statement and penalty are submitted within 7 days of receipt of this decision; \$800 if they are remitted within 8 to 30 days of the receipt of this decision; \$1,200 if they are remitted on or after 31 days, but within 90 days; and \$1,400 if they are received after 90 days
