
NOTICE OF REASONABLE CAUSE

Pursuant to Executive Law §94(12)(a), the Commission on Public Integrity ("Commission") finds that there is reasonable cause to believe that Powers & Company knowingly and willfully violated Legislative Law §§1-e(a)(4) and 1-h(b)(5)(i), by failing to timely file a Statement of Registration and accurately report the compensation received from your client, BearingPoint, Inc. in January 2006.

As required by law, a copy of this notice is retained by the Commission for public inspection. Please be advised, that pursuant to Legislative Law §1-o(b)(i) a lobbyist, public corporation, or client who knowingly and willfully fails to file a statement or report within the time required for the filing of such report, shall be subject to a civil penalty for each violation in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars. In addition, pursuant to Legislative Law §1-o(c), a lobbyist, public corporation, or client who knowingly and willfully files a false statement or report shall be subject to a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed the fifty thousand dollars, to be assessed by the Commission.
