
IN THE MATTER OF SHEINKOPF LTD.

NOTICE OF REASONABLE CAUSE

Pursuant to Executive Law §94(12)(a), the Commission on Public Integrity ("Commission") finds that there is reasonable cause to believe that Sheinkopf Ltd. knowingly and willfully violated Legislative Law §§1-c(h) and 1-j, by failing to timely file a 2007 July/December Client Semi-Annual report, accurately reporting compensation paid to Norman Levy.

As required by law, a copy of this notice is retained by the Commission for public inspection. Please be advised, that pursuant to Legislative Law §1-o a lobbyist, public corporation, or client who knowingly and willfully fails to file a statement or report within the time required for the filing of such report, shall be subject to a class A misdemeanor and shall be subject to a civil penalty for each violation in the amount not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars or three times the amount the person failed to report properly or unlawfully contributed, expended, gave, or received, to be accessed by the Commission.
