Advisory Opinion No. 92-15: Extending the financial disclosure filing requirements for individuals serving in academic titles at the State University of New York and City University of New York

In Advisory Opinion No. 90-15, the State Ethics Commission, pursuant to its authority under Executive Law §94(15), established a financial disclosure filing process to govern individuals serving in academic titles at the State University of New York and the City University of New York effective commencing September 1990 until August 1992. At that time the Commission would determine whether the procedure is effective and, if so, would issue permanent rules and regulations to continue it.

Pending the Commission's review of staff's recommendations and action to modify, renew or adopt all or part of the financial disclosure filing process for academics, Advisory Opinion No. 90-15 shall remain in effect. This opinion, until and unless amended or revoked, shall be binding on the Commission.
